

## Installation Process DRYWALL



For Operable / Awning windows, drywall should return back to the window frame with a corner bead at the edge. We provide enough 4" MDF trim to serve as floor base and door casing, not as a window casing. PRIOR EXPERIENCE IS RECOMMENDED.

## For Fixed Glass Windows / Lites:

- Install **fiberglass batt insulation**. Wear protective glasses and mask to avoid dust.
- Install nailer boards in all corners. **Any scrap 2x lumber will work.** See photo 1 Circled in orange.
- There should be drywall in between the wood window stops where necessary, but **no drywall on window returns themselves.** The edge of window stop should be **flush with the face of drywall**. Install corner bead.
- Tape and apply skim coat including window returns. In the window returns, skim coat will be directly on the wood. See Photo 2.
- Install drywall as **ceiling of shed**. Beetle Kill planks included if purchased with kit.
- Use the vendor's instructions to install vapor barrier and laminate flooring. Then install baseboard along the interior perimeter of building. If desired, case around door. We do not supply casing for windows.
- \* For operable/awning windows, use drywall returns with corner bead to cover the gap between window frame and rough opening/framing. See photo 3.
